About the Use of This Manual

Please read this manual thoroughly since the information in it may allow you to know how to operate your car safely and properly, and enjoy your driving at maximum.

The illustrations in this manual are for reference only. Please read this manual before using the entertainment and navigation system, and strictly follow the instructions for operation

No part of this publication may be reproduced, stored in a retrieval system or transmitted in any form, electronic, mechanical recording or other means without prior written permission from the company.

Important Safety Information

- Do not attempt to fit, repair or modify the entertainment system by yourself, because there are high-voltage components in the device, which may cause electric shock. For internal inspection, adjustment or repair, please consult a local Authorized Repairer.
- Do not allow this entertainment and navigation system to come into contact with liquids. If liquids or foreign objects enter into this entertainment and navigation system, please park your vehicle at a safe place, immediately switch off the ignition and contact a local MG Authorized Repairer. Do not use the entertainment and navigation system in this condition because doing so may result in a fire, electric shock, or other failure.

- If the entertainment and navigation system has smoke, abnormal noise or odor, or any other abnormal sign shows on the LCD screen, please cut off the power immediately and contact a local MG Authorized Repairer for service. Using the entertainment and navigation system under such condition may result in permanent damage to the system.
- It is strictly prohibited to operate the entertainment and navigation system while driving, so as to avoid the influence on the traffic safety caused by inattention. Please park your car in a safe location and apply the parking brake before making the necessary adjustments or watching "Video Picture".
- Extreme high/low temperatures will interfere with the normal functions. If you shut down the engine and park the car in direct sunlight or at a

- cold place for a long period of time, it may become extremely hot or extremely cold in the car, the entertainment and navigation system may not work properly in such environments. Once the internal temperature returns to the normal range, the system will restore the normal function. If it is unable to restore, please contact a local MG Authorized Repairer for service.
- In case of vehicle refuel, you shall power off the entertainment and navigation system.
- In order to avoid the battery from running out, make sure to start the vehicle engine while using the entertainment and navigation system, otherwise it will cause the battery to run out.
- If the battery is disconnected or runs out, the data in the memory of the entertainment and navigation system will be cleared.
- · The navigation function of entertainment and

navigation system is used for assisting you to drive. The routes and navigation information displayed by the entertainment and navigation system are for reference only. Thus please make sure to observe the rules for safe driving, actual traffic lights and all the current traffic rules.

- When using a mobile phone, keep the mobile phone away from the screen to prevent disruption of the video signal in the form of spots, colored stripes, etc. on the screen.
- To protect the screen against damage, be sure to touch the panel buttons with your finger (a touch pen can be used for special calibration).

Instructions

 This manual contains important information and warnings & instructions for entertainment and navigation system. For additional information related to the safety of your own and occupants, please refer to other manuals accompanied with the vehicle.

- Please do not use vehicle heat insulation film or similar products on the windscreen, otherwise, GPS or internet signal shielding may occur.
- The GPS positioning result of the entertainment and navigation system is for driver's reference only.
 In case of any abnormal situation, please drive according to the actual road condition.
- Communication signal will be subject to the signal coverage range of service provider; if there is no signal, part of services relying on network will be restricted.
- Maintain the volume of the voice prompt at an appropriate level while driving, so that you can be aware of the road and vehicle condition.

 After switch off engine and lock doors, the entertainment system will also shut down. if you want to continue the use at this time, you need to press the power button, but there is a risk of low vehicle battery power, please restart the engine.

Cautions for Using Screen

- Please protect the screen against direct sunlight.
 Extended exposure to direct sunlight will result in screen malfunction due to high temperature.
- When the temperature is above or below the operating temperature range (-20°C to +65°C), please do not use the LCD screen, because the screen may not operate normally and could be damaged.
- Make sure that the warm or cool air from the air conditioning system will not be distributed to the screen directly, damages to the entertainment

- navigation device may occur due to heat or moisture.
- Do not make drag-and-drop operation or press the screen hard, otherwise, scratches and damages may occur.
- To remove dust from the screen or clean the screen, please turn the system off first, and then wipe with a dry soft cloth. When wiping the screen, take care not to scratch the surface. Do not use irritative or abrasive chemical cleaners.
- When the backlight reaches the end of its service life, the screen will become dimmer and the image will no longer be visible. In that case, please contact an MG Authorized Repairer for service.

- For some types of external storage devices, the entertainment system may not be able to identify them, or to correctly play the files.
- Because of file characteristics, file format, recorded application, playback environment, storage conditions, and so on, it may not be possible to play some music files normally.

This chapter describes the functions of physical buttons



1. Volume- Button

Press to turn down the volume.

2. Volume+ Button

Press to turn up the volume.

3. Home Button

Press to return the home page.

1. Left ★ Button

When the Ouick Menu One-touch Open mode is selected:

Short press to open the guick menu.

When the CarPlay/Android Auto mode is selected:

Short press to open the Apple CarPlay or Android Auto function.

When the AVM One-touch On/Off mode is selected: Short press to open/close the 360° function.

2 Phone Button



Short press to answer the call or hang up the phone. Long press to reject the call.

3 IPK mode Button



When the right ☆ Button is selected for SRC mode:

Short press to arouse or turn off the IPK mode.

4.Right ★ Button



When the SRC mode is selected.

Short press to switch to next available media audio source.

When the AC mode is selected:

Short press to arouse or turn off the air conditioner panel.

5. Right multi function Button



5.1. When the SRC mode is selected and the IPK mode is not selected:

When playing music:

Press the button to the left to go back to the previous song, Press the button to the right to forward to the next song.

When using radio:

Press the button to the left to seek the previous radio frequency, Press the button to the right to seek the next radio frequency.

Press the top edge of the button to increase the volume, Press the lower edge of the button to decrease the volume, Short press the middle button to play or pause the media audio source.

5.2. When the AC mode is selected and arouse the air conditioner panel:

Press the top edge of the button to increase air volume, Press the lower edge of the button to reduce the air volume, Press the left edge of the button to Reduce the air conditioner temperature, Press the right edge of the button to Increase the air conditioner temperature.





Bluetooth Phone

Instructions

- Connection to all mobile phones featuring Bluetooth wireless technology is not guaranteed.
- The mobile phone used must be compatible with the entertainment system so that all functions of Bluetooth phone of the system can be normally realized.
- When using Bluetooth wireless technology, this entertainment system may not operate all functions on the mobile phone.
- When transmitting voice and data via Bluetooth technology, the straight-line distance between this entertainment system and the mobile phone should not exceed 10 meters. However, the actual transmission distance may be shorter than the estimated distance, depending on the usage environment.

- If Private mode is selected on the mobile phone, hands-free call function may be disabled.
- When the entertainment system is turned off, the Bluetooth connection is also disconnected.
 When the system reboots, the system will automatically attempt to reconnect the previously-connected mobile phone. Even when the connection is terminated for some reasons, the system will automatically reconnect the specific mobile phone (except when the connection is terminated due to mobile phone operation).
- Since Bluetooth adopts wireless connection, interruption or error may occur in the process of transmission in some extreme cases, so that the entertainment system cannot be paired and connected with a mobile phone. At this time, it is recommended to clear the paired devices in the

device list on the mobile phone and entertainment system, and conduct pairing again

Bluetooth Enabling, Pairing and Connecting

1. Enable the Bluetooth Function

The Bluetooth setting includes Bluetooth on and off, device name, Bluetooth state, etc.

- Touch [Bluetooth] in the [Setting] on the main interface to enter the Bluetooth setting interface.
 - Touch to enable Bluetooth function, vice versa.
- If the Bluetooth is turned on, the interface will display device name, vice versa.

2. Pairing and Connecting

After enabling the system Bluetooth function, start to pair and connect the mobile phone with the HU through Bluetooth.

- I Enable Bluetooth function on the Bluetooth device and search the entertainment system to pair.
- 2 The Bluetooth device will receive the Bluetooth pairing request sent by the entertainment system.
- 3 After the pairing is completed, a prompt message of connection completion will be displayed. If the pairing failed, please repeat the procedure.
- 4 Touch device name to connect the device's Bluetooth.
- 5 Swipe and touch " un"to delete the

Air Conditioner

Air Conditioner

Click on the AC module in the main interface to enter the air conditioning settings page.

The air conditioning settings page contains the following features.

Air Conditioner Switch

The user can operate the air conditioner by clicking the switch. Air conditioning can be adjusted after the air conditioner is turned on.

A/C Switch

Click on the A/C switch to operate the air conditioning compressor. The cooling function can be activated when the air conditioner compressor is turned on.

ECO Switch

Click on the ECO switch to start economic mode.

Auto Switch

Click on the auto switch to start auto mode. If you want to adjust the blower speed, auto mode will be existed.

Temperature Adjustment

Adjustment of the temperature can be realised by using the temperature adjustment scroll.

Blower Speed Adjustment

Adjustment of the blower speed can be realised by using the up and down adjustment button to adjust the air conditioning blower speed.

Air Circulation Mode

Touch the air recirculation mode touch button to switch between air recirculation modes.

Front Defrost

Press the physical front defrost button on the console board to activate front defrost.

Rear Demist

Press the physical rear demist button on the console board to activate rear demist.

Internal recirculation.

During internal recirculation, the air conditioning system circulates the air inside the car to meet the requirements of rapid cooling or heating, and at the same time, it can prevent the entry of traffic fumes

External circulation.

During the external circulation, the air conditioning system draws air from outside the vehicle to ensure fresh air enters the vehicle.

Automatic circulation.

During automatic circulation, the air conditioning system can automatically adjust the internal recirculation or external circulation according to the situation. Note: Leaving the system in internal recirculation mode can cause the windscreen to mist. If this happens, turn on the defrost/demist mode.



ΕV

Touch [Energy Management] in the main menu to enter the EV Management Mode, including charge settings, discharge settings, energy consumption and charging station*.

1. Charge settings

- Display the current charging status.
- Switch off the vehicle power system, connect the charging equipment, lock the car. The vehicle will commence charging (on commercial chargers it may be necessary to swipe your charge card or arrange payment).
- Click 'Stop charging', the car will stop charging.
- Click 'Start charging', the car will start charging.



- Click the 'Charging Settings' button to proceed to the 'Charging Setting' interface.
- Click the 'Scheduled charging 'switch to set the scheduled charging parameters.



2. Discharge settings

- Plug in the discharge connector to display the current discharge status.
- After setting the discharge power limits, click the 'start discharging' button.
- The vehicle must be connected to suitable electrical appliances in order to allow discharge level settings and commence the discharge process.
- Click 'Stop discharging' when the discharge requirements are complete, disconnect the discharge equipment plug.



3. Energy consumption

- Click the energy consumption button.
- You can view following details of energy consumption: energy consumption map in 50km, energy flow, total power consumption.



4. Search Charging Station*

- Click the search charging station button.
- You can view following details of charging stations: Name, Address, Type of Connector, Charging Type, Distance and Amount of Available Chargers.
- You can click GO to navigate to the charging station



Map Information

Road network characteristics are included in the map database of map information. Features include street name, street address, and turn restrictions. The detailed area includes all main roads, side roads and community roads. Detailed areas include points of interest (POI), such as restaurants, airports, banks, hospitals, police stations, charging stations, tourist attractions, and historical monuments. The map database may not include new areas or corrections to the map database completed after drawing. In the detailed map area, the navigation system provides complete route guidance.

Interactive with Map

You can interact with the navigation display by touching different areas of the screen. To explore the map, you can:

- Zoom in:

 - Spread the index finger and thumb out
 - Double tap with one finger
- Zoom out:
 - Tap "-"
 - o Pinch the index finger and thumb in
 - Tap with two fingers
- Pan:
 - Drag one finger left, right, forward or backward
- Rotate map:
 - Place thumb and index finger on map and rotate both to the left or right
